 - a. Meeting called to order at 7:02pm.
- II. Roll Call – A. Coryell

- III. Approval of Minutes from last meeting – S. Coryell
 - a. Motion to approve –1st J. Cheney, 2nd L. Despot, all approved.
- IV. President Update – S. Coryell
 - a. Great fall season with some big expenses that may not be necessary next year.
 - b. May 2016 reevaluate homecoming tent zone for the 2016-17 season.
 - c. May 2016 reevaluate concession discount cards for paid workers for the 2016-17 season. Amount of paid workers not as high in spring as in fall with football.
 - d. Board approved via email additional \$3,000 grant for baseball. Motion to approve a formal review of the grant 1st J. Cheney, 2nd N. Jones, all approved.

- VII. Athletic Director Report – D. DeBruycker
 - a. Board approved black/gold sweatshirt that will be given to all state qualifying athletes. D. DeBruycker will forward artwork to board for approval. This is to replace the \$25 allowance per athlete that was approved in spring 2014.

VIII. Financial Report – J. Cheney
