Metea Valley Booster Members,

As was proposed and posted on our web site on January 26, 2014, the booster board is conducting its biannual review of our bylaws. Below you will see the three suggestions that have been made. These three will be put up for a vote in our April 21, 2014 meeting. All are invited to attend, participate, and vote.

### **Proposed Bylaw changes**

In accordance with the bylaws of the Metea Valley Athletic Boosters, the following suggestions have been made for consideration in the April general meeting.

#### **Article VI, Section 1**

It was questioned whether or not the most recent past President should get an automatic voting position on the new executive board. It was proposed that this not be an automatic voting position going forward.

#### **Article VIII**

It has been requested that the section limiting board members to only serve two consecutive years in the same office be amended to allow for longer terms in the same office. It is being suggested that a board member can be voted in, on an annual basis, to the same office in one year increments. This position would then be voted upon annually in the same manner as any new board member that is voted into office in accordance with the bylaws.

#### **Article X, Section 4**

It has been suggested that section 4 be amended such that any monies under \$500 be subject to a simple majority vote as is written in section 5 of Article X.
