ARTICLE XII: Amendments

Section 1

These Bylaws may be altered, modified or added to at any time by affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of all voting members present at any regular or special meeting, provided a quorum of eight (8) voting members (as defined in Article 5, Section 3) is present.

Section 2

No amendment to any of these Bylaws shall be valid unless written notice of the proposed amendment(s) shall have been publicized to all members not less than ten (10) days prior to the date of the next meeting at which a vote on the amendment(s) is to take place.

Section 3

A thorough review of the Metea Valley High School Athletic Booster Club Bylaws shall be conducted biennially (every odd calendar year) within a month following the April Annual Meeting to assure that the Bylaws remain consistent with the mission and intent of the Booster Club. Any proposed changes are to be publicized to all members not less than ten(10) days prior to the date of the next meeting at which a vote on the amendment(s) is to take place.
